Conflict resolution is the process of resolving a dispute or a conflict by meeting at least some of each side's needs and addressing their interests. Conflict resolution sometimes requires both a power-based and an interest-based approach, such as the simultaneous pursuit of litigation (the use of legal power) and negotiation (attempts to reconcile each party's interests).

Case Studies: Examples of Conflict Resolution

Conflict, work-related stress and sickness absence. Conflict in the workplace resulting in significant discord or disagreement can result in hostility between work colleagues (Martinez-Corts et al, 2015). This may be associated with ill treatment and unacceptable behaviours such as lack of courtesy and disrespectful behaviour (Sliter et al, 2011).
